An agreement between the partner agencies of Coordinated Hispanic Family Resources
1994-1995

- 1) Each CHFR partner agrees to provide a representative with decision making authority to serve upon the Proyecto Planning Team, and other representatives as necessary to serve upon action teams.
- 2) Each CHFR partner will agree to provide all of their respective resources to assist in parent education for Hispanic families. These resources will remain the property of the individual partners, but will be jointly housed at the CHFR Family Resource Center. These resources will be available to any interested community member. They will be maintained by the Proyecto Coordinator.
- 3) Each CHFR partner will utilize the coordinated parent education schedule and series, and agree to provide which ever portions of those series that are agreed upon through the Planning or Action Teams.
- 4) Each CHFR partner agrees to respect the confidentiality of the children and parents with which they come into contact.
- 5) Each CHFR partner agrees to abide by any agreements, contracts, or sub-contracts which they enter into on behalf of their agency.

I, the undersigned representative, do hereby agree to the points stated above. I also acknowledge that I am duly authorized to enter into this agreement on behalf of my agency.
