#### **DIRECTOR'S COLUMN**

Jerralynn Ness, Executive Director

I am pleased to announce that all of our hard work over the past few months to reduce expenditures has made a significant difference to the overall health of our programs and the agency. As you know, we took a number of cost saving measures in a very short period of time, which are now showing strong results.

CAO ended fiscal year 1999-2000 with a small cash surplus after reducing our overall cash flow problem by several hundred thousand dollars. We have kept current with our bills since April and project that we will remain current. We exceeded our \$700,000 fundraising goal by raising \$777,000 in private funds, up from \$500,000 the previous year. Our approved budget for 2000-2001 is based on good financial data and history, projects a year-end surplus and does not rely on any unsecured revenue to support program operations. This is what we refer to as a zero-based budget. We now have better fiscal tools in place for Directors and Managers to closely monitor their budgets and financial activity. CAO has stabilized its financial situation and is in a much stronger position to support current programs and advance our mission.

Staff is continuing to plan for changes in their programs as we respond to either reduced or expanded funding, developing new models for delivering services. New faces are joining the organization and we continue to say goodbye as some staff move on. We sorely miss those who have been a part of our family, but wish them the very best and hope that we all stay in touch.

Thanks to everyone for all that you have done to help us get through a very challenging year. If you have any questions about this memo or changes occurring, please don't hesitate to ask your Director or any member of the Management Team (which includes Jerralynn, Leon, John, Sharon BB, Renee and Marilyn). I'm looking forward to seeing everyone at the picnic and hoping that you are all enjoying the "last days" of summer.
