I helped move Mrs. McAllister. I had an OK from her worker, Mrs. Kieger to hire a truck and get some paid help to move her.

March 11, 1968

I called Father Weise about a meeting. He can't make it. Marjorie Stewart contacted, says she will come. I talked to Mrs. Sylvester about rentals for a migrant family. Mrs. Prebe called at the office to get clothing for her family. She will try to attend the Tuesday night meeting. I called on Mayor, Adrian Eischelberger and invited him to attend the Wednesday afternoon luncheon at Kelly's Restaurant in Beaverton. He will talk on Sherwood area at the court house meeting. I called on Jim Parrott, president of JC's and discussed youth club, and projects planned for the city park. I called Marjorie Stewart to compile data on Sherwood resources for the Wednesday meeting. I supervised tutoring class in evening and attended swim club meeting.

March 12, 1968

I made phone calls and planned meeting for this evening. I had a consultation with Gretchen about NYC help. I helped Mrs. Prebe with some clothing.

I attended the meeting in the evening at Washington County Court house.

March 13, 1968

I talked with Pete about the meeting, then called Rev. Harden and made appointment for Pete. I talked to Mrs. Webb and she doesn't need a ride to Hillsboro. I went to luncheon in Beaverton with Mayor Eickenburger and discussed Sherwoods problems. I made an appointment with welfare for Mrs. Bergland, and counseled Mrs. Bergland and her mother, Mrs. Snead. Both signed up for tutoring class beginning next Monday afternoon. I talked to Mrs. Mikan about MDTA and called counselor, Mrs. Campbell. She made arrangements to drive him to the unemployment office, Thursday. I delivered shoes to Mrs. Prebe.

March 14, 1968

I called on Pat Smiley and left cards for immunization clinics and papers for volunteers to fill out. I picked up Mr. Mikan and took him to employment office. I attended seminar and then picked up abundant food for Mr. Mikan, Ellingwoods and Daltons. I counseled Mr. Mikan about job training. I called the Civil Service and Legal Aid for Mikans.

March 15, 1968
