ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION Amended May 7, 1995 OF

WASHINGTON COUNTY COMMUNITY ACTION ORGANIZATION

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is the Washington County Community Action Organization, and its duration shall be perpetual.

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<u>Purpose</u>: The general purpose of the Washington County Community Action Agency, hereinafter referred to as WCCAO, shall be to increase the availability of those community services necessary to promote the well-being and self-sufficiency of economically disadvantaged residents of Washington County, while striving to break the cycle of poverty.

<u>Responsibilities</u>: The responsibilities of WCCAO shall be as follows:

- 1. To serve as the local Community Action Agency to contract, receive, and dispense funds in connection with, but not limited to the 1981 Community Services Block Grant Act and any amendments thereto.
- 2. To exercise all of the powers granted to a non-profit corporation under the Oregon Non-Profit Corporation Act as limited by Section 501 (C) (3) of the Federal Internal Revenue Code.
- 3. To remove obstacles and solve problems which block the achievement of self sufficiency for the economically disadvantaged.
- 4. To engage in efforts which achieve greater participation of the poor, in the affairs of the community; that coordinate and establish linkages between governmental and other social service programs; and to encourage the use of entities in the private sector to ameliorate poverty.
- 5. To provide a range of services having a measurable and potentially major impact on causes of poverty, including, but not limited to:
 - a. To secure and retain meaningful <u>employment</u>.
 - b. To attain an adequate <u>education</u>.
 - c. To make better <u>use of available income</u>.
 - d. To obtain and maintain adequate housing.
 - e. To obtain emergency loans, grants, or assistance to meet urgent needs.
 - f. To make more effective <u>use of other related services and programs</u>.
 - g. To counteract conditions of starvation and malnutrition.

ARTICLE III

The number of directors constituting the board of directors of the corporation is 18.

ARTICLE VI

Upon dissolution or final liquidation of the corporation the assets of the corporation shall be distributed in accordance with a plan of distribution adopted by the board of directors; provided, however, all liabilities and obligations of the corporation shall be first paid, satisfied and discharged, or adequate provision shall be made therefor, and assets held by the corporation upon condition requiring return, transfer or conveyance, which condition occurs by reason of the dissolution of final liquidation, shall be returned, transferred, or conveyed in accordance with such requirements.

Assets, if any, held by this corporation upon condition requiring return, transfer or conveyance, which condition occurs by reason of dissolution or final liquidation, shall be returned, transferred or conveyed in accordance with such requirements.

Any remaining assets not held by this corporation upon condition requiring return, transfer, conveyance, which condition occurs by reason of dissolution or final liquidation, shall be returned or conveyed to one or more comestic corporation funds or foundations organized, created or operated exclusively for charitable, scientific or educational purposes as defined in Section 501 (c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or, if a public purpose, to the United States of America, the State of Oregon, or Washington County, said transfer or conveyance to be pursuant to a plan of distribution which shall be adopted in a meeting of the board of directors upon receiving a vote of the directors in office.
