 birds sent there some years since,
 and the balance remains in my hands. A Spectro-
 scope and chemical balance have been ordered,
 which will be of about that cost, but have not yet arrived.

The Faculty have remitted during the year 2 1/2
 terms of tuition, amounting to \$3,000. They would be glad
 of some further direction in this matter, as they
 are doubtful how far they are at liberty to go.
