SUBJECT: Governor's pledges to Indian tribal conference yesterday

For your information, just in case these matters arise again, the Governor made the following pledges to the Indian tribal representatives in the Q & A segment of the meeting yesterday:

1. He said he would respond to Indian complaints about John Donaldson, and J.D.'s role in the Power Planning Council fisheries plan, if those complaints were put into the form of a letter addressed to him personally.
2. He said he would work to see to it that an agenda item on Indian treaty rights is included in the upcoming Western Governor's Conference meeting in Kalispell, MT.
3. He said he would either speak to or send a letter to Spellman ('for what it's worth'), opposing two Memorials now before the Washington Legislature (SJM 107 & HJM 120)--- both of which ask Congress to support termination of Northwest Indian tribal status.
4. He promised to make certain that you or Dave Talbot could brief the Indians Friday morning about the Gorge Agreement with Spellman. (this has been done, Talbot will appear).
