

Albany Or Aug 5 1905

Dear mama

Just a few lines this morning  
Glenn came very near going  
over today, but he don't like  
the idea of having to start back  
so early Monday morning.

If it can be arranged I think

I'll let him go some time  
before you return. Cliff phoned  
up last evening that he wanted  
Glenn to come after him

this evening, so Glenn has  
just phoned over that he will come.

I am going to have after-  
manure, <sup>Red</sup> worked in the corn  
patch yesterday and cleaned up  
the mustard, except a few rows. It  
is good under.

I send letters that will be  
of interest - though I doubt -

if you can fully make it out.  
Wolcott's, though I made out  
every word by reading 2" lines.  
I wish I could be there tomorrow.  
It starts in like we were going  
to have more warm weather.  
I gave a write up of my  
different mountain climbing  
and sent to Wolcott.

Try and get hold of a Sunday  
Oregonian Monday, or some time  
next week. Did you have to  
pay on Vernal. The bear crop  
is about gone I picked quite  
clean last evening thinking  
Gleim might go.

If I knew you wanted them real bad  
I'd ship them, and some apples &  
onions. Later I send small box by Express.  
Well bye-bye With our love

Mrs Thomas said May's Papa  
wrote she would start for Portland the 3<sup>rd</sup> by steamer.
