Dear Sir:

I am one of J. L. Luckey's Bondsmen, and a claim from Government for failure in sending Vouchers &c, has occurred to the amount of over \$6000.⁰⁰. I am entirely satisfied that the whole matter was caused by Sam Lester as Clerk. He tried to have Luckey threatened and himself put in the position, but failed. When disbursements were made, Sam Lester would draw the Vouchers, and obtain Luckey's signature thereto, and then suppress the Vouchers, and not send them. Consequently Luckey would not

receive the proper credits. We want
Mr Walker (your son in law) to work
the matter out for us. I am told
he succeeded in doing so for you
on your settlement. Mr Walker
could do more than any other man
in that respect, having had experience
before in such matters. If he will
undertake the matter, the Bondsmen
will see that he be paid for his
services. I would have written
this to Mr Walker, but did not know
his given name, nor address.

me immediately.
