SUBJECT:

Far East Trip

We need to reach decisions on the Japan/China trip as soon as possible. Many of the issues need full discussion with you. Denny and I are scheduled to meet with you 7/12, Thursday at 10:00 a.m.

## 1. Itinerary:

Depart Portland UAL to Tokyo	- Tues., Sept 4
Arrive Tokyo	- Wed., Sept 5
Stay Tokyo -	9/5 thru 9/15
Depart Tokyo -	Sept 16
Arrive Beijing -	Sept 16
Stay Beijing/Fujian	9/16 thru 9/22
Depart Beijing/Fujian	Sept 23
Arrive Singapore	Sept 23
Stay Singapore	9/23 thru 9/26
Depart Singapore	Sept 26
Arrive Portland	Sept 26

Itinerary is choice of Governor. Flights, etc., need to be confirmed by EDD.

## Issues to be decided:

## a. time not spent in formal activities

- 1) Japan - golf
  - private entertainment
  - shopping
  - sight-seeing

Recommendation: leave more flexible time than usual

- 2) China - major attractions (at least one day)
  - shopping

Recommendation: if Fujian is part of itinerary, add 2 days to China

## b. United Airlines - Portland

- 1) arrival and departure are only on Tuesdays

Recommendation: depart from Portland; extend trip to arrive back in Portland which would mean return on Oct. 2 rather than Sept. 27 which coincides with proposed extension of time in China

c. Rest upon return - essential  
Recommendation: unscheduled time from date of return  
until first budget hearing on Oct. 9.

2. Sister-state agreement with Fujian Province.

Governor's decision: EDD is to begin working on wording  
and agreement. Caution: be careful of pending Taiwan  
agreement.

Issue: How much of the designated official party will be  
included in Japan?

Issue: Do we want tandem missions in China?

Recommendation: a single small to moderate sized mission  
only accompanied by Governor.

Issue: Philosophy and criteria need to be carefully  
discussed with advance team. Governor must be  
included in this discussion.

5. Media participation

- a. raise importance to EDD
- b. if PRC limits, how is selection made

Issue: Primary interest is in China. Negotiations with the PRC must be successful in allowing as much media as possible.

Recommendation: Governor must make it clear that extensive media coverage is necessary.

Recommendation: Involve Denny Miles in negotiations with PRC.

Currently 12 members of media have requested accompanying Governor to China. Two more requests are expected.

2 person crew - KOIN-TV
- B. 2 person crew - KEZI, Eugene

Channel 2 is not expected to go because they have just returned from China.

NOTE: As much coverage as possible is absolutely necessary. Previous coverage of the Mideast trip has established amazement in other Governors' offices and states. We need to keep the positive momentum and coverage for the Governor, the state and future economic development efforts.

6. Spouses -- invite or not

- A. Dolores goes as a member of official party
- B. No other spouses invited -OR-
- C. *SPOUSES OF OFFICIAL PARTY ONLY*

Issue: Dolores must make an absolute decision within 10 days in order to complete official party arrangements in both countries.

Issue: recommendation of D. Miles because of past involvement and experience.
