The Department of Human Resources has no appropriation from which to assist employable, single persons or childless couples.

The street people who are being "released" by the Rajneesh are childless and employable; therefore, there is no assistance for them.

No AFS office in the Antelope area is aware of any Rajneesh who is receiving any form of assistance from AFS.

There is one single lady who, as a result of broken ribs, became eligible for GA (General Assistance) while living in Portland. She is moving to the Madras area where her eligibility--both medical and financial--will be re-evaluated. These are normal procedures for any client who changes place of residence.
