SUBJECT: Gates - Rajneeshpuram

The Highway Division tells me it is unclear where the gate is that was referred to at the August 12 meeting. It seems clear, however, that the gate is not located on a Wasco County Road. If we could have a more specific description where the person found the closed gate, Highway Division personnel could look to see what problems, if any, exist. We have, however, been in contact with officials from both Wasco and Jefferson Counties, and they tell us that there are no locked gates on the county road running through Rajneeshpuram at either end of the city.

The City does not receive any funds from the Highway Division that go toward maintaining the county road; however, the City does receive State tax street funds, as do all cities. Those funds may be used on any of the City's streets.

Finally, any governmental agency may request traffic signs to be made by the Highway Sign Shop. These signs are paid for by the requesting agency, not the State.
