Trends Affecting Anti-Poverty Efforts (RESEARCH, INTERVIEWS)

- Political (Shifting of programs to the states, fiscal austerity, etc.)
- Economic (Growth of underclass, growth of local economy, etc)
- Social (Erosion of social responsibility, conservative attitudes, growing intolerance,)
- Technological (Increase demand for technical skills, agency networking, etc.)
- Philanthropic (Growing burden/demand on philanthropy, trends in giving, etc)
