It wasn't because I didn't know the wright time to go to the train but because I didn't get the letter intill dark that night, that I wasn't at the train to see papa. I got the two dollars from Walter Hemree alright. I was so sorry not to see Pappa. It is as you say I will be home in less than a month now any how.

Your letter didn't come untill Friday I suppose you wanted

untill Pappa got home. I
wish I could milk for Pappa.
If it hadnt been for my
papers I would have rilled
in and taken supper with you
as you say. I would have
come home on that \$2:00 that
Pappa left as I could have come
home for \$2.60. People dont
miss it much when they say
I have a good place to stay.
I get \$1.40 a month more for the
telegrams from now on. Lyman
got a football for a birthday
present. Well I gess this is as
long as your letter.
